



Wellington High School UPDATE Roxanne Henry

On Wednesday, May 30th, 2018, 25 to 30 of Wellington High School students planted, trimmed and cleaned up under the direction of WGC member, Roxanne Henry, and Ms Karen Clawson from the Environmental Club. Christmas Palms were added around the school since they are very slow growing and add a more tropical ambiance. Before the end of the school year, the students will meet again to plant 50 to 80 small firebush donated by the Village of Wellington. We plan to re-group again in September to trim and clean up the plants that were left to grow over the summer.

Wellington High School is a large, old school with many old, diseased bushes that have only survived because God is there watching over them. Many of these bushes will be replaced with flowering bushes that are weather and drought tolerant. This year we used \$400 donated by Wellington Garden Club to purchase the eight (8) Christmas Palms. During the 2018-2019 season, we plan to purchase more large palms or flowering trees.
