

*A PROCLAMATION OF THE
VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA
DESIGNATING JUNE 3RD - 9TH, 2018 AS
"NATIONAL GARDEN WEEK"
IN THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON*
