- 2. All exhibits must relate to horticulture, gardening, design, or other NGC goals, objectives and/or initiatives. HB p. 95
- 3. The photographer must be a member of NGC and by invitation, and may submit one entry per class.
- 4. Registration is required by February 3, 2020, with the Botanical Arts Photography Entries Chair Paige Griffin (561) 310-5119 agri349229@aol.com.
- 5. Only eight (8) entries per class will be accepted. Entry cards will be provided by the Photography Entries Chair.
- 6. For each entry submit 5" x 7" matte finished prints and same images on a CD or flash drive. Completed 2.5" x 4" title card of entry, and identify any plant material in photo(s), preferably with current scientific designation provided by Entries Chair. Photo's, entry card and CD or flash drive should be submitted together in envelope provided by Photography Entries Chair.
- 7. Submissions must be received by the Photography Entries Chair Paige Griffin by Monday, February 10, 2020.
- 8. Entries will be pre-judged during the week of February 10, 2020. The four (4) winning entries in each class will be matted by the committee and entered in the show by the Entries Chairman on Thursday, February 27, 2020 between 3-5 PM. (see Show Timetable on inside front cover page)

Include title and identify plant material, preferably with current scientific designation, if known, on 2.5" x 4" card provided by committee. Winning entries will be mounted together on mat board and displayed under natural and artificial indirect lighting by the committee.
