II. Officer Reports

- A. President's Report:
- 1. The Lifesaver Award was given to Alison Albury, for the awesome job she did at the October 4, 2021 membership "Bring a Friend" meeting.
- 2. Attendance We had 54 members and 16 guests at the October 4, 2021 meeting, for a total of 70! Twenty five percent of the "friends" already joined the garden club! So, "bring a friend" month was truly successful!
- 3. Sip 'n Stroll will be at Anne Hlasnicek's house on Friday, November 5, 2021 from 4-6 PM. Bring an appetizer to share and the drink of your choice.
- 4. A Thriller Flash Mob will be at the Wellington Mall tonight, October 27th, at 5:30 PM.
- 5. The Village of Wellington is holding a Veterans' Day Parade on Thursday, November 11, 2021. If you wish to participate, be at the Village Hall at 7:45 AM. The parade will begin at 8:15 AM. IV. Special Committee Reports

- A. Holiday Luncheon Linda DeSanti told us that Christine Biscoglio will conduct the auction. Michael Whitlow will donate a basket for it. Many past presidents have been invited to join us at this holiday luncheon on Monday, December 6, 2021 at the Wanderer's Club to help celebrate the 40th anniversary of the WGC. Some of them will try to be there. The food choices for the luncheon are: chicken piccata, glazed salmon and a vegetable platter. Paige Griffin will discuss "Toys for Tots" gifts at the November 1st Members' meeting.
- B. Garden Tour Carol Coleman, accompanied by Carol Ralph, Joan Kaplan, Bobbi Ziegler and Twig Morris toured the gardens of Linda Umla, Petra Russell, Uma Bhatti, and Gary and Amy Swedenborg and selected their gardens for the Saturday, April 2, 2022 Garden Tour fund raiser. There are a few other gardens they will visit at a different time.

Since there has been no change in the \$25 ticket price for the tour, it was suggested that we consider charging \$25 for tickets bought in advance and \$35 for tickets sold the day of the tour. We will also consider on-line sales.

Carol Coleman also stated that she has District X Garden pins available for \$5.

C. Fertilizer - Jan Seagrave spoke about 3 different fertilizers she had checked out and compared them to the fertilizer we had sold in the past. There were 2 different types of Neutracote and one unnamed fertilizer, plus the existing one we had used previously. The prior one was a 3 stage fertilizer, good for 360 days, with a ratio of 13-5-11 ingredients. She recommended a no stage Neutracote, good for 150 days, with a ratio of 18-6-8, for \$69.44. The second place recommendation was

unnamed. It also had no stages, good for 360 days, with a ratio of 16-5-11, for \$60.69. The last suggestion was for a 2 stage Neutracote, good for 180 days, with a ratio of 17-7-8, for \$72.56. That one was also higher in nitrogen. Linda DeSanti said that she would be the repository for the fertilizer if the semi-truck that would deliver it could get to her house and out again! Also discussed was the suggested choice of Mounts Botanical Gardens which is Site 1 time-release fertilizer, with a ratio of 8-2-12. There was a concern mentioned that there might be too much phosphorous leaching into the water. Lots of discussion on this topic! Jan Seagrave will check on Espoma.

V. New Business - Linda DeSanti has several WGC scrapbooks from our past and wanted to know if anyone else had books from past years. Twig Morris said she had many of these books. They will coordinate what they have.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:53 AM.
