The Richard and Pat Johnson Palm Beach County History Museum

The museum is located on the 2nd floor of the restored 1916 Courthouse at 300 North Dixie Highway, in downtown West Palm Beach. Link on Google Maps: <u>https://goo.gl/maps/atPhpUHcBDH2vDp36</u>

We will carpool from our East & West carpool locations – arrive before 9:15 at your chosen location. We will leave no later than 9:15.

Cost is \$5.00. This will be given to the museum as a donation.

We will have a guided tour of the Historical Society of Palm Beach County which is the world's leading resource for Palm Beach County history. It houses a permanent collection of millions of objects and images that span over 1200 years of Palm Beach County and Florida history. In addition to its permanent People and Places galleries, the Johnson Palm Beach County History Museum presents temporary exhibits on a wide variety of topics. The temporary exhibit is titled "From Houses to Hospitals" and examines how Palm Beach County's modern healthcare system developed and expanded during the Roaring '20s.

Join us for an inspired docent-led tour as we learn about the history in our own back yard.

For parking, the most convenient is a county lot on 4th Street with the entrance near Olive Avenue. The payment kiosk is practically across from the back of the 1916 Courthouse. This is the shortest walk to the first-floor entrance to access the elevators. There is a city parking garage at the corner of Banyan and Olive. If you use this one, it is recommended to walk down Olive to go in the back entrance rather than climb the stairs at the front.
