Bus Trip and Guided Tour

Cost: \$55.00 which includes bus transportation, admission and box lunch. Meet at the Wellington Community Center at 8:15AM.

Flamingo Gardens is a 60-acre not-for-profit wildlife sanctuary, aviary and botanical garden. It is one of the oldest botanical gardens and attractions in South Florida whose mission is to depict, preserve and provide education about the natural and cultural heritage of South Florida and the Ever-glades. The day will begin with a guided walking tour and then sit down for a Wildlife Encounter show. A box lunch will be provided. After lunch there will be a narrated tram ride through 42 remote acres to see some of the last original jungle growth in South Florida that remains as it was for over 100 years when the Seminole Indians occupied it. The ride continues through a hammock of 200-year-old Live Oaks, a tropical rainforest and tropical fruit groves and mitigated wetlands.
