



Wellington Garden Club Board Meeting October 25, 2023 Youth Garden Clubs-Kathy Siena

WGC sponsors two elementary schools, two middle schools and two high schools. We have six volunteers that work with the teachers and students at each of the gardens. Our approved budget overall is \$1600.00. WGC has supported Pine Jog Elementary school for more than 12 years and it is one of the largest and most active elementary school gardens. We recently met with the Principal and teachers at the school to discuss their plans and needs for the coming year. They are in great need of replacing a very old hydroponic garden that is managed by the older elementary students and teachers. They want to develop a butterfly garden that students of all ages there can develop and they need new raised beds for a kindergarten vegetable garden.

John and I have been working with our youth for seven years in the Community Garden at the Boys and Girls Club. Unfortunately, we had to resign from managing those vegetable gardens and the butterfly garden. However, we are happy to say that we can continue to advise and work with the Youth Garden Clubs along with our other great volunteers. For these reasons, I would like to propose that we apply the \$450.00 Community Garden budget for Pine Jog Elementary School Gardens. The Boards vote of full support for this request would be greatly appreciated.
