The Elliott Museum in Stuart, Florida, is a unique museum on Hutchinson Island focusing on art, history, and technology, known for its extensive collection of classic cars, trucks, and motorcycles displayed in a robotic racking system. It features Exhibits, a large baseball memorabilia collection, local history galleries, and an 1880s-style general store, all operated by the Historical Society of Martin County. The museum celebrates the legacy of inventor Sterling Elliott, for whom it is named, and offers a blend of Americana, local history, and interactive displays.

A bus is provided by HSM to take us to the House of Refuge and back to Elliott Museum.

The last surviving House of Refuge in Florida has entered an exciting new chapter. Discover immersive experiences, fresh exhibits, coastal stories, and the enduring spirit of those who found safety here.
